(Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation) Order 2014 (Variation No. 29) Order 2016

Notice is HEREBY GIVEN that Swindon Borough Council made the above Order under the provisions of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and The Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to introduce 'no waiting at any time' on the roads in Eldene as follow:

**Islandsmead (both sides) at the junction with Eldene Drive
Overbrook (both sides) at the junction with Eldene Drive
and both sides at the junction into Properties No's 5 to 30
Overbrook.**

**Acorn Close (both sides) at the junction with Eldene Drive
Collingsmead (both sides) at the junction with Eldene Drive
Eldene Drive (east side) at the junction with Collingsmead**

The Order will be operative as of 6 February 2017 and a copy of the sealed Order and plan may be inspected at the One Stop Shop, Wat Tyler House, Euclid Street, Swindon during opening hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 1 February 2017 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
